Methodology Statement - This Cardinal Point Analytics poll was conducted by telephone and consisted of a random sample of likely voters in North Carolina. The poll sampled approximately 550 likely voters. Ninety percent of the poll was conducted using automated dialing, while 10 percent were drawn from cellphone users. Weighting was used to ensure the demographics of the survey respondents match the statewide demographics as determined by the US Census Bureau. Weights are applied to race, location, and political party. The accuracy of the survey due to sampling is plus or minus 4.2 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence level. Sampling error associated with crosstabs is much higher. Cardinal Point Analytics does not collect personally identifiable information of respondents. We do not know how any particular person or household answered the survey.

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
